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As we approach this year's Financial Town Meeting (FTM) where the townspeople vote on a budget that determines what their property taxes will be, it's time to look at where the taxes go. This is especially important at this time as we are potentially facing huge, double-digit tax hikes again this year. An informed voter can make the difference.

The current town budget is \$9,160,805 as determined

last May at the FTM. The School budget is 60% of that or \$5.526.082 (includes the loan). Another way of slicing the budget is to look at the salary & benefit package for Town and School employees. It is 63% of budget the or \$5,783,927 (based upon what was appropriated at the FTM last May).

The Little Compton **Taxpayers** Association requested and received the Wages and Benefits paid to all employees during calendar year 2004. The wages are total wages including overtime based upon employee W2 information. The following two tables show where a major portion of the tax funds were spent.

The figures shown in the two tables represent money that was paid by the taxpayers of Little Compton for calendar year 2004. Including substitute teachers and others unnamed in the tables, 193 people received \$5,783,927 in compensation from the Town in 2004. The "BENEFITS" columns do not include individual Pension costs as they were not available. The total Pension cost for all in town, however, was budgeted at \$443,061.

Because the W2 data available to us was for calendar year 2004, and because the Town's fiscal year (FY) begins on July 1st, the totals shown in the table represent half of FY-04 and half of FY-05.

benefits, and non-salary appropriations for the current fiscal year. As can be seen, the salary & benefit pieces make up 63% of the total budget.

The benefit package for all employees totals \$1,833,761 broken up as follows:
